transcribed them with some modifications in volume III of his *Autobiography: The Story of My Life in the Plan of the Great Mercy of God*, pp. 1140 ff (cf. *Epistolario* 1:212n, 218n). This work is from 1912: one of those years which passed in the life of Father Dolindo with the cadence of a "Way of the Cross" ... But he, serene as ever, loved Christ the more, loved Our Lady the more and reflected this love in these few pages to which he wished to give the significant title: *A Profound Reform of Heart in the School of Mary*. These meditations are written in the style of the *Imitation of Christ*. Meditations for just one soul!
